- Two-Person teams
- Individual play is net stroke play. Team member A will have a lower average and team member B will have a higher average.
 Each team will have the opportunity to earn up to 6 points every week. The point opportunities are as follows:

A v A - 1 point B v B - 1 point A player shooting average or better - 1 point B player shooting average or better - 1 point Team v Team - 2 points

• All ties earn 1/2 point

- Men play from the Rock Tees.
- Women play from the Gold Tees.
- Seniors (60+) must play from Blue Tees.
- Lift clean and place through the green outside of penalty areas. Within a scorecard.
- If a ball is lost in a wooded, heather or other penalty area, it is to be played as a lateral hazard. Marked or not.
- Putts may be conceded by opponents.
- Each team will be issued one scorecard prior to play. This is the final scorecard!
- · Both teams must sign the card
- Once the scorecard is turned in, there WILL NOT be any changes to the card
- If the card is lost, please report to the the pro shop after play is finished
- All scores are final
- Double par is max on every hole.
- Each player is responsible for finding their own sub.
- Subs without an established handicap, will be given a handicap by the committee.
- Averages are all based on the player's previous four scores.
